

Collage Maker PRIVACY POLICY Collage Maker (“we” or “us” or “our”) respects the privacy of our users (“user” or “you”). This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you use our mobile application Collage Maker (the “Application”). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THE TERMS OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY, PLEASE DO NOT ACCESS THE APPLICATION. If we make any changes to this policy, we will change the “Last updated” date above. You should periodically review this Privacy Policy to stay informed of any updates. This Privacy Policy does not apply to the third-party online/mobile store from which you install the Application or make payments, including any in-game virtual items, which may also collect and use data about you. We are not responsible for any of the data collected by any such third party.

**COLLECTION OF YOUR INFORMATION** Collage Maker does not collect personally identifiable information from our users. We do not ask you to register to use the App or collect your name or email address. All photos and videos remain on your device unless shared by you. Depending on your use of the app, the following information may be collected:

- Derivative Data** Information our servers automatically collect when you access the Application, such as your native actions that are integral to the Application, including favorites and liking songs or video styles, as well as other interactions with the Application.
- Mobile Device Access** To provide App functionality to you, we request access, solely with your permission, to certain features from your mobile device, including your mobile device’s camera, microphone, and storage. If you wish to change our access or permissions, you may do so in your device’s settings.
- Transaction Data** If you choose to make a purchase in the App, information related to your purchase is collected directly by our platform partners. We do not collect or store any financial information. We receive information from our partners confirming the purchase to authorize your use of the app.
- Mobile Device Data** To provide App functionality and track installations, a random identifier is attributed to your device. Should you uninstall the App, this number is no longer attributed to you.

**USE OF YOUR INFORMATION** Having accurate information about you permits us to provide you with a smooth, efficient, and customized experience. Specifically, we may use information collected about you via the Application to:

1. Notify you of updates to the Application.
2. Offer new products, services, mobile applications, and/or recommendations to you.
3. Compile anonymous statistical data and analysis.
4. Increase the efficiency and operation of the Application.
5. Monitor and analyze usage and trends to improve your experience with the Application.
6. Perform other business activities as needed.

**DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION** We may share information we have collected about you in certain situations. Your information may be disclosed as follows:

- By Law or to Protect Rights** If we believe the release of information about you is necessary to respond to legal process, to investigate or remedy potential violations of our policies, or to protect the rights, property, and safety of others, we may share your information as permitted or required by any applicable law, rule, or regulation.
- Third-Party Service Providers** Through your use of the app, you may share your information with third parties that perform services for us or on our behalf, including payment processing, data analysis,

hosting services, customer service, and marketing assistance. Affiliates We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us. Sale or Bankruptcy If we reorganize or sell all or a portion of our assets, undergo a merger, or are acquired by another entity, we may transfer your information to the successor entity. If we go out of business or enter bankruptcy, your information would be an asset transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur and that the transferee may decline honor commitments we made in this Privacy Policy. We are not responsible for the actions of third parties with whom you share personal or sensitive data, and we have no authority to manage or control thirdparty solicitations. If you no longer wish to receive correspondence, emails or other communications from third parties, you are responsible for contacting the third party directly.
